Isaiah—The Miniature Bible

- Isaiah has 66 chapters.
- Bible has 66 chapters.
- Two main divisions:
 - The first division contains 39 chapters, just as the OT contains 39 books. It emphasizes God's judgment upon immoral and idolatrous men.
 - The last division contains 27 chapters, just as the NT contains 27 books. It presents God's grace through the promise of a Redeemer, and concludes with final judgment. As does the NT, these chapters declare a message of hope in the promise "*to bear a cross and wear a crown.*"
